With the increased investment in light rail infrastructure, developers and city leaders have identified rail stations as major catalysts for development. Transit Oriented Development (TOD) is a critical strategy to addressing environmental concerns and reducing LA's car culture. But if it is not implemented in an just & equitable way, mounting evidence shows that it can have major negative impacts on low income communities. Join residents and community organizations from across the City who share a common vision for Just, Equitable, and Sustainable TOD. We'll hear about the grassroots organizing and research work residents have done in the past year to identify the impacts of TOD in their neighborhoods, and we'll work together to develop a strategy that stops displacement and gentrification around public transit.
